




DATE NIGHT

Clean typography, modern colors and design aesthetics, and striking imagery make this app not only current, but something that you'll look forward to opening.




Introducing a new image allowed for my design to begin delving into an alternative layout. After creating their profile, the user is encouraged to select types of activities that they are interested in so that the app can suggest dates that the user will enjoy.







In designing the main page, or homepage/profile, I really began utilizing the idea of having different tabs. The first screen in this series is your suggested dates for today where the app lists dates that you might like to do that day. The second tab serves as a calendar or log of all past dates the user has been on. The third tab lists dates that the user has favorited.








